






Performance Report Card Sales Tax Revenue


YTD - Sales Tax Through July 2014





Performance Report Card Property Tax Revenue


YTD Property Tax – Through July 2014






Performance Report Card Development Fee Revenue

Development Revenue – Through July 2014






Performance Report Card Lodging Tax Revenue






Performance Report Card Credit Rating






Performance Report Card General Debt Level Per Capita






Performance Report Card Pavement Management Funding






Performance Report Card Building Repair & Replacement Funding
