



## Tips for practicing safe social distancing with Arts Month:

- Be aware of capacity limits and register in advance where required.
- Keep a distance of 6 feet or more between you and others.
- Wear a face covering in public spaces, when you cannot maintain 6 feet distance from people not from your household.
- Avoid crowds.
- Limit social gatherings.
- Wash your hands with soap and water, often.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Cover your mouth/nose with a tissue or sleeve when coughing or sneezing.
- If you are sick, stay home.
- Avoid contact with people who are sick.
- If you are at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19, we encourage you to limit activities that put you into contact with people outside your household.
