Background

The Olympia Police Department and Crime Victims Advocacy Network of Thurston County are partnering in the promotion of the new SAFE OLYMPIA initiative. This program is designed to reduce hate crimes and harassment to Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Questioning (LGBTQ) residents and visitors. It also aims to encourage the victims of these crimes to report incidents so the perpetrators can be held accountable. This initiative invites businesses, organizations, and schools to be temporary safe havens for victims of hate crimes, where victims fleeing hate crimes can call 911 and wait for help to arrive.
