

RESOLUTION NO. TBD-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE OLYMPIA TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT BOARD EXEMPTING FROM FEE ASSESSMENT THE OLYMPIA ADDRESS USED BY PARTICIPANTS OF THE ADDRESS CONFIDENTIALITY PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2008, the Olympia City Council established the Olympia Transportation Benefit District (TBD); and

WHEREAS, TBD fees apply to any vehicles registered to an address within the Olympia city limits; and


WHEREAS, Address Confidentiality Program participants are crime victims using a substitute address within the Olympia city limits to protect disclosure of their actual location; and

WHEREAS, the majority of Address Confidentiality Program participants do not reside within the Olympia city limits, yet are charged the TBD fee and must request a refund from the TBD for each vehicle charge, every year; and

WHEREAS, the time it takes to administer refunds to participants living outside of Olympia outweighs the revenue collected by those Address Confidentiality Participants who actually live in Olympia;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE that the Olympia TBD fee shall not apply to the address used by Address Confidentiality Program participants, effectively immediately, and the TBD Board President is hereby authorized to take whatever action is necessary to effect such purpose.
