The Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) was determined to be the lead SEPA agency for the above-mentioned project as acknowledged in the City of Olympia letter of December 24, 2015. WSDOT has issued a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) for this project based on the information provided by the City in the SEPA checklist.

The SEPA DNS was published in the *Olympian* on May 18, 2016 to provide the public an opportunity to comment on the project. The public comment period ended on June 1, 2016. The Washington State Department of Ecology submitted the only comment for this project which is attached for your files and information. No further action is required. The effective date of the DNS is June 1, 2016.
